

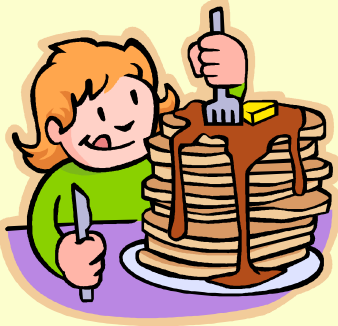

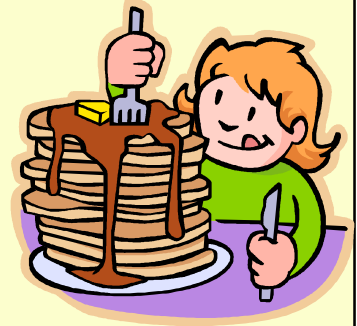

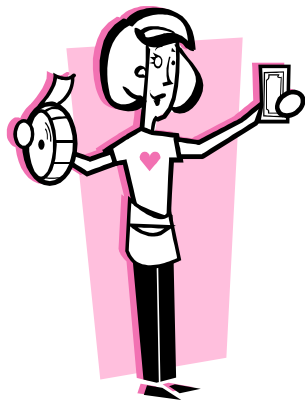
**Everyone**, we need all of you to come to the Legion March 28th and buy the baked goods. All proceeds go towards assisting disabled veterans.

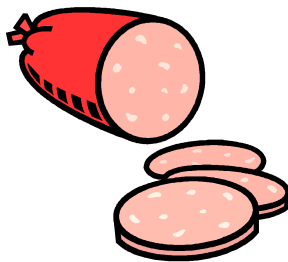
## Combined District 18 Meeting February 22nd
